GOAL 8 DECENT WORK AND ECONOMIC GROWTH

Target 8.4

Improve progressively, through 2030, global resource efficiency in consumption and production and endeavour to decouple economic growth from environmental degradation, in accordance with the 10-year framework of programmes on sustainable consumption and production, with developed countries taking the lead

Green Economy in Sweden

- No distinct strategy/policy but incorporation of environment in economic decision making
- Green Economy working group in Prime Minister's Office
- Government budget 2016 propose climate, environment and energy investments focused on technological development and innovation, accelerating progress to achieving the national environmental and climate objectives, and increased climate finance to developing countries
- Environmental and CO₂ taxes, renewable energy certificates remain key policy tools



TOWARDS IMPLEMENTATION OF SDGs

- Majority of targets are not yet achieved, but few raise new policy areas in Sweden
- Opportunity to integrate sustainability in existing policy processes and politics, align sector objectives, and align domestic and foreign agendas.
- Target setting and a meaningful national implementation plan requires a government-led, inclusive, process for interpreting the agenda for the Swedish context.



- - -

- Comprehensive and complex agenda put high demand for integrated planning and action across policy areas; requires new or adapted organizational structures
- Policy Coherence for Sustainable Development as useful framework
- Prioritize relevant action over global monitoring, and develop accountability frameworks that track progress on national targets

Target 5.2

Eliminate all forms of violence against all women and girls in the public and private spheres, including trafficking and sexual and other types of exploitation

Target 10.1

By 2030, progressively achieve and sustain income growth of the bottom 40 per cent of the population at a rate higher than the national average
